## Excluded Occupations (Applicable to Tiq Personal Accident only)

Occupations with exposure to highly hazardous conditions and all manual work that requires the Insured Person to be working at thirty (30) feet above ground level.

- Underground and handling of hazardous chemicals or explosives
- Pilots and air crew
- Shipbreakers
- Ship crew and vessel workers
- Stevedores (longshore or dockworkers handling cargo and machinery)
- Asbestos industry
- Atomic or nuclear related industry
- Casino industry
- Crude petroleum, oil and natural gas extraction (including drilling)
- Entertainer (actor or actress, singer, performer, artiste)
- Fishing industry
- Jockey
- Logging and saw mills
- Mining industry
- Professional sportsmen
- Quarrying
- Race track worker
- Racer (motor, aircraft, boat, horse)
- Road construction, pipeline and maintenance worker
- Scaffolder
- Space and research technology industry
- Tunnelling
- Weapons, ammunition and accessories manufacturing
